CUCSC Code of Conduct.

Everyone who attends any CUCSC games or training:

In addition to all relevant Codes of Conduct established by FFA①, FNSW② and MFA③ including social media, sports betting, match fixing and anti-doping policies....

I will accept that all players and officials are human and that mistakes are part of life.

I understand that verbal abuse, the use of bad language and harassment of players, coaches, managers, officials or spectators, is not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport.

I will not arrive at any venue intoxicated or drink alcohol at any non licensed venues.

I will not arrive at any venue under the influence of illegal drugs or participate in the use of drugs at any venue.

I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.

In accordance with Section 6A of the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000, I will not smoke in any spectator or playing areas at any public sports grounds and other recreational areas in NSW when an organised sporting event is being held. In addition to actual game time, this includes during set up of the first game of the day until after the pack up of the last game of the day and all before, during and after all training sessions.

I will enjoy the game regardless of the result and try to ensure those surrounding me enjoy it too.

Players:

In addition to the CUCSC Code of Conduct established for "everyone"...

I will always play by the rules.

I will never argue with an official. If I disagree with a decision I will inform the captain, coach or manager during a break or after the competition.

I will work equally hard for myself and/or my team.

I will be a good sport and applaud all good plays whether they are made by my team or the opposition.

I will treat all players in my sport as I like to be treated. I will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.

I will cooperate with my coach, team mates and club officials.

I will participate for my own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.

I will thank the opposition and officials at the end of the game.

I will assist when I am required to by my coach, manager or club official.

Coaches/Managers:

In addition to the CUCSC Code of Conduct established for "everyone"...

I will promote the development of good football, remembering that players participate for success, growth and enjoyment.

I will never ridicule or verbally abuse players for making a mistake or not winning.

I will be reasonable in my demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm.

I will operate within the rules and spirit of the game and teach my players to do the same.

I will ensure that the time players spend with me is a positive experience.

I will ensure players of all abilities receive equal attention and opportunities.

I will display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport including opponents, referees, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. I will encourage my players to do the same.

I will show concern and caution toward sick and injured players and follow the advice of a physician when determining whether an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.

I will obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up to date with the latest coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young players.

I will assist when I am required to by a club official.

Parents/Spectators:

In addition to the CUCSC Code of Conduct established for "everyone"...

I won't pressure the players in any way - I know that this is their game not mine

I will encourage the players to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions - no matter what.

I will teach my child to respect the efforts of their opponents.

I will remember that children learn best by example so I will applaud good plays/performances by both my child's team and their opponents.

I will give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort.

I will focus on the players efforts and performance - not the score.

I will thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time to conduct the event for the players.

I will assist when I am required to by the coach, manager or club official.

I won't criticise or ridicule the players' performance after the game.
